With 80% of the RV buying decisions being conducted by women, it is important for them to also find other women within the technician field.

Through no fault of their own, men being present in this type of environment creates an added layer of intimidation for women. Thus, we created an all-female program for women to learn from a female RVTI master certified technician in a judgement-free environment. This certification is good for life and will allow recipients to broaden their knowledge/skills in the RV industry.
